Overview

Presto for Chrome is a new category of enterprise software that allows users to discover services on their network.

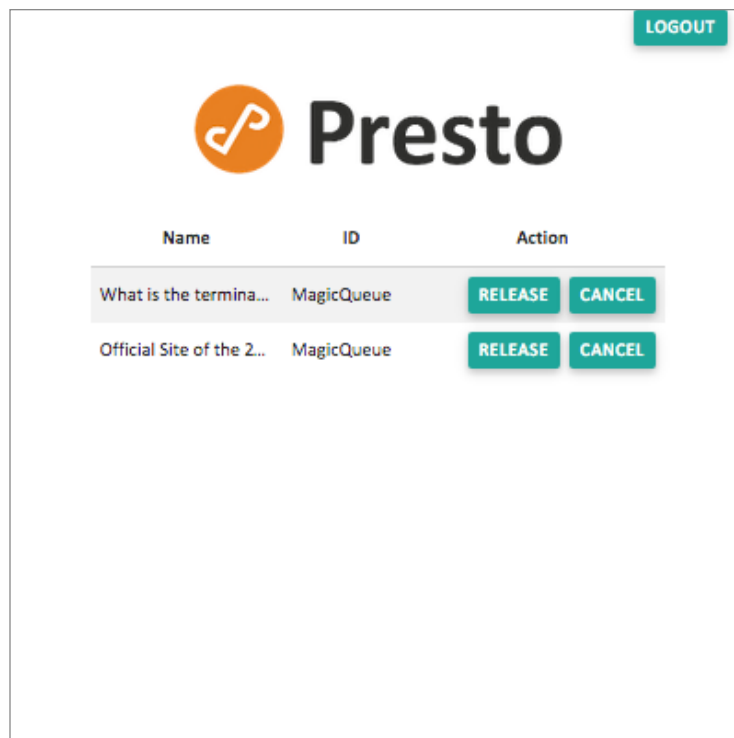

Setup

Presto for Chrome is an app that plugs into the Chrome printing framework.

The app presents a list of held jobs that can be released to printers that are available to the current Presto user as in Figure 1.

Presto Users

The Presto User is not necessarily the same user that is logged into the ChromeOS device. This enables sites that have Google logins but have different logins to in-network resources.

Features

Magic Queue

The Magic Queue is an on-device queue that allows users to “print” jobs locally to the device that can then be released to an actual printer at a later date. This is useful in a wide variety of different scenarios, not the least of which is when the user is not on a Presto enabled network. The user can print to the Magic Queue, and then when back on a Presto enabled network, they can release the job to any printer they have rights to.
